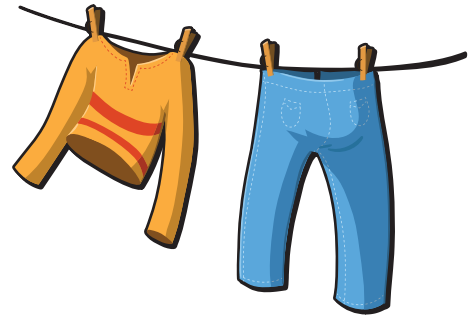




How Do You Use Natural Gas?
